

Pronouns - Best Practice

-It is hard to change language, but we need to so we can care for others. Practice is key! What does that look like? By yourself, or with others...

“Elmo is cool. He is cool.”

“Nala is smart. She is smart.”

“Kazi is tough. They are tough.”

Repetition is important!

Correcting yourself:

“Yeah I was talking to her- I mean him and he said...”

“Oh that’s funny, he told me tha- they told me that and it...”

1. Notice you made the mistake
2. Resay what you were intending to say with the correct pronoun
3. Move on.
4. No apologies necessary
5. Nothing about how hard it is (we know)
